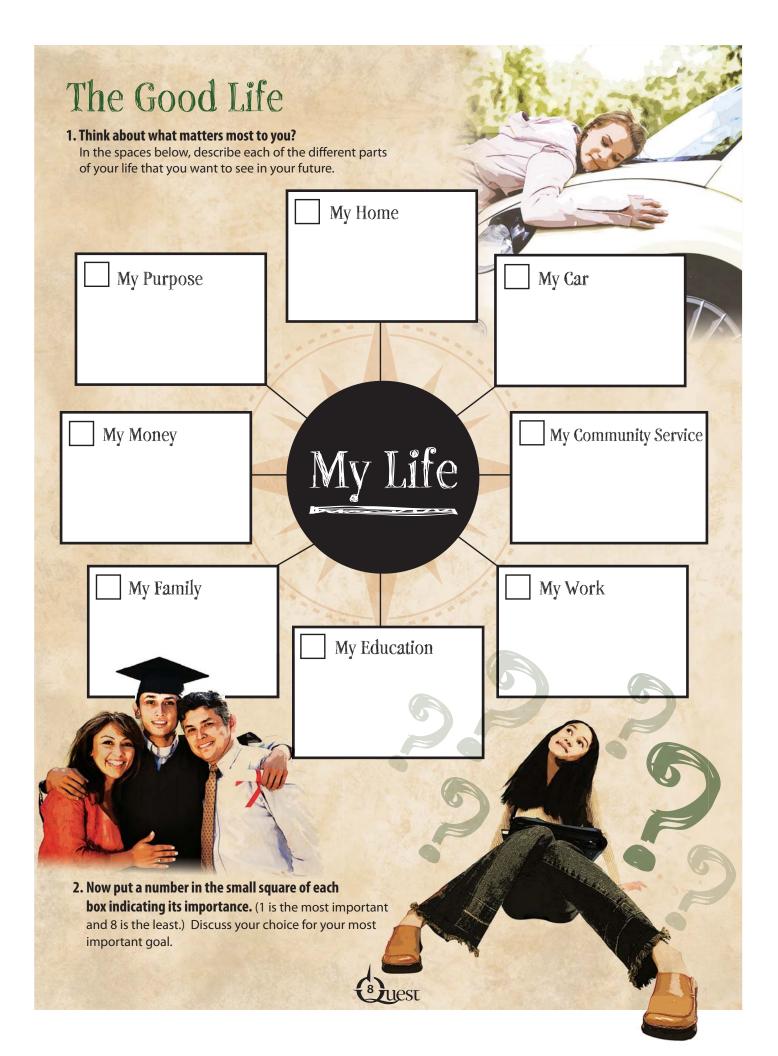
### In high school ...
