Mini Implant Services

Mini dental implants are smaller in diameter than a regular dental implant. They are specially designed to be used in situations where regular implants cannot fit. These small diameter implants (SDI) are perfect for securely fastening a denture. The Locator Overdenture Implant System (LODI) used in our office is the most popular implant overdenture attachment method in the world.

To secure a denture, mini implants (2-8) are placed into the jaw bone. These mini implants are slightly above the gum line, allowing a denture to be made to snap onto them. Another benefit of mini implants is the denture can usually be placed right away or only a short time after. Most often we don't have to wait for the implant to heal before securing your denture. This is because the Locator Overdenture Implants are designed to be strong and stable the same day they are surgically placed in the mouth.

Mini implants are also <u>significantly less expensive than regular implants</u>. Mini implants are usually not a substitution for regular sized implants. They are best used to retain dentures, not to replace a single missing tooth (unless a regular dental implant will not fit). If the cost of attaching your dentures to implants was too high previously, mini implants may be the answer you have been looking for.

If you want to get rid of that sloppy, poorly fitting denture so you can eat like you did when you had teeth, give us a call and let us use mini implants to give you the solid denture you've always wanted.

At Bitterroot Dental we have a Dental Laser that is used during some hygiene appointments. Many patients have questions regarding why we use the laser and what the benefits are.

The Laser is primarily used for Laser Bacterial Reduction or as we commonly call is LBR. This laser provides antibacterial qualities that helps selectively kills bacteria which helps reduce periodontal pockets. It is also more comfortable than traditional methods of cleaning periodontal pockets. The treatment has shown better long term results when combined with traditional cleanings. It has over a 99% reduction in bacteria making it the most effective cleaning possible.

There is no better way to improve the health of your mouth than adding the laser to your cleanings. It is completely painless!
