## Notice of Non-Covered Services and Acknowledgement of Financial Responsibility for Sublingual Immunotherapy



Allergy drops (also known as sublingual immunotherapy, or SLIT) are NOT covered by health insurance carriers because it is not FDA approved. As such, treatment with allergy drops will be an out-of-pocket expense.

The out-of-pocket expense for sublingual immunotherapy is \$135 for a 3 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> month supply titration set and \$70 for 1 month supply maintenance vial, each titration/maintenance set will hold up to 25 allergens (price is subject to change). It is important to remember that this will be a recurring monthly expense as treatment typically lasts a minimum of three years. Please note that this dollar amount works out to be about \$2 a day.

It is the patient's responsibility to notify our office two weeks before running out of supply in order to take care of the out-of-pocket expense and for the sublingual immunotherapy to be custom made by our staff. A monthly automatic withdrawal from your credit card is available to you.
