Student Dress Code

The role of the school staff is to educate students and to maintain an environment in which students can learn. All students shall attend school dressed in appropriate, clean, intact clothing as follows:

A student's appearance or clothing may not be disruptive to the learning environment.

Shirts: All students must wear shirts with no distracting graphics (at the discretion of the staff and administration) on the front or back. No spaghetti straps, halter or strapless tops or revealing necklines. Shirts must cover from the shoulders to the top of the pants. Bare midriffs are not permissible. Shirts must be tucked in if they extend below the bottom of the hip. No racer back tops. No undergarments (including straps) may show underneath tank tops.

Shorts, skorts, skirts, or pants: Allowed with no tears, holes, shredding, or worn spots. Pants may not be oversized, baggy, sagging or worn so that underwear is showing. Pant legs must be off the ground. Cut offs are not allowed. Shorts, skirts, skorts, and dresses must not be above mid-thigh when sitting or standing. It is suggested that shorts or tights be worn under skirts and dresses. Jeans with holes worn with leggings or tights are not acceptable. Leggings or tights may not be worn separately. No pajama bottoms.

Hats: No hat of any kind may be worn inside the building but are acceptable outside the building.

Hair: Hair may not be dyed unnatural colors (pink, purple, bright orange, green, blue, etc) and must have a clean, combed appearance. Distracting hairstyles are not acceptable. Examples include, but are not limited to mohawks, designs shaved on the scalp, long spikes, etc. Staff and administration will make the final determination.

Shoes: Must be worn at all times. Sandals are acceptable. No flip-flops or slippers. Appropriate athletic shoes must be worn with socks during physical education.

Undergarments may not be visible.

Clothing that features alcohol, drug, tobacco or gang references or sexually suggestive logos or sayings is not allowed.
