
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# Weekly Theme Description

<p>Week 1 June 15 - June 19</p>	 <p><b>Under the Sea</b></p>	<p>FasTracKids will dive deep into the ocean and become FasTracK Oceanographers. We will explore animal life and experience the wonders of the ocean through experiments and art projects. Where else can you learn dolphin calls or test the saltiness of the ocean water?</p>
<p>Week 2 June 22 – 26</p>	 <p><b>Yummy Art</b> Art that's good enough to eat</p>	<p>Get your spoon, paintbrush and chocolate syrup ready – we're going to create Art! From cupcake design to mosaics with food to chocolate syrup painting – it's all about the wonderful and wacky world of food art! We'll build spaghetti sculptures, learn about food artists such as Vic Muniz, and play "foodie" games. We'll even make our own incredible edibles!! (No peanut or peanut oils will be used.)</p>
<p>Week 3 June 29 – July 2</p>	 <p><b>Awesome Earth Adventure</b></p>	<p>The Earth reveals its wonder and variety as FasTracKids explore climate, geology, and the amazing forces of nature. Learning Station based activities and games, as well as hands on experiments, allow children to take imaginary journeys examining the compositions of the Earth from its surface to its core.</p>
<p>Week 4 July 6 - 10</p>	 <p><b>Creative Arts and Artists</b></p>	<p>FasTracKids express their creativity through canvas painting and sculpture and gain inspiration from the study of famous artists from the past including Van Gogh, Matisse, Picasso, Monet, and O'Keefe.</p>

<p>Week 5</p> <p>July 13 - 17</p>	 <p><b>Magnets, Molecules, and Mystery</b></p>	<p>FasTrack scientists conduct experiments involving magnetism, flotation, and molecular change of matter. Looking at water in different forms, experimenting with buoyancy and even floating an egg, children will gain and understanding of the scientific observation process and analysis.</p>
<p>Week 6</p> <p>July 20 - 24</p>	 <p><b>Ready, Set, Travel</b></p>	<p>During this whirlwind tour of the world, FasTracKids will travel through the amazing countries of India, Mexico, China, and Australia. Along the way, campers will taste the foods of each culture, experience and demonstrate cultural traditions and create artwork from each land...all without leaving the classroom!</p>
<p>Week 7</p> <p>July 27 - 31</p>	 <p><b>Spencer Learns Sports</b></p>	<p>FasTracKids become professional athletes as they learn the rules and history of sports such as baseball, cricket, and many more. Every day encompasses a body warm up involving stretching and yoga, as well as fun games and activities simulating the wide world of sports. Children will be actively participating in learning and fitness!</p>
<p>Week 8</p> <p>August 3 - 7</p>	 <p><b>Anatomy of Me</b></p>	<p>The human body is an amazing machine! Discover what goes on underneath your skin through experiments, demonstrations, and crafts. FasTracKids will explore how medicine dissolves in our bodies, what digestion really looks like, and how our muscles and bones keep us together!</p>

<p>Week 9</p> <p>August 10 – 14</p>	 <p><b>Destination Constellation</b></p>	<p>Blast off to the stars as FasTracKids become FasTronauts. Explore how astronauts live and work in space through role playing weightlessness and gravity. Investigate the surface of the moon, the difference between shooting stars and comets and discover if there really is life on Mars.</p>
<p>Week 10</p> <p>August 17 – 21</p>	 <p><b>Rainforest Exploration</b></p>	<p>FasTracKids travel deep into the jungle and learn about the amazing wildlife that the rainforest hides beneath its canopy. Campers explore each level of the rainforest through the study of plant and animal life and even taste what the dense environment has to offer.</p>
<p>Week 11</p> <p>August 24 – 25</p>	 <p><b>Going Green</b></p>	<p>Green kids care about the environment, and we do, too! Abrakadoodle Green Kids create French Santon statues inspired by peasants from the Provence region of France. They'll produce CD art in the style of Piet Mondrian, Chilean Rain Sticks Each work of art is a masterpiece made with recycled materials that both decorate our world and help to constructively reuse and recycle materials in our environment.</p>
