**IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO**

● **What should I wear?**

- Clothes you can move in comfortably, yet not overly baggy.
- If you have jazz dance shoes, bring them. However, you do not need to run out and buy a pair if you don't own them. Athletic type sneakers are a fine alternative (such as ones made for running, walking and cross training), and be sure to always wear socks. Try to avoid flat sole sneakers, and absolutely no sandals, flip flops, Crocs, or boat/swim shoes.
- Please shower every day and wear deodorant.

● **What should I bring with me?**

- Bring these things every day of camp:
  - Water bottle (filled with water or Gatorade...NO soda, sugary juices and the like)
  - Packed lunch (please no soda, sugary juices, etc.)
  - A positive, respectful attitude and a desire to learn
  - A small notebook and pencil
  - Any necessary personal items that must be with you such as medical devices, medication, personal hygiene items, etc.
  - A change of "street clothes" for when camp is over (optional)
  - A backpack to contain all these items above and keep your belongings together
- Bring these items on the *first day of camp* (in addition to the above):
  - Two contrasting songs that you like to sing and you can relate to them in some way
  - Either sheet music for these two songs (preferable), or a karaoke version on your mp3 player, iPod or smart phone (a Capella is acceptable, but not preferable for this exercise)
    - These two songs do not have to be "show tunes," but they should be very different styles from each other and be ones that fit your personal taste

● **What NOT to bring with me?**

- Do not bring any personal items that may cause distractions.
- Do not bring any items that are valuable (monetarily or sentimental).
- Do not bring guests.

● **What else should I know?**

- It's important to have something for breakfast BEFORE you arrive.
- Try to arrive at the theater about 10 minutes early.
  - Sign-in
  - Put your bag where it is supposed to go
  - Quietly begin stretching until the day's teacher begins
- There is no running, climbing, roaming/exploring on your own at any time.
- If you have a smartphone or camera, bring them to take pictures with the teachers at the end of class, and ask as many questions as you wish during the Q&A periods each day.
